

USE OF E-READERS at IHM-ST. CASIMIR SCHOOL

Nooks, Kindles, iPads and other e-reader devices will be allowed in the IHM-St. Casimir classroom for reading books by students in the 4th through 8th grades. The students are prohibited from using the e-reader to access internet, games, social media, etc. The e-reader must be used strictly for reading books. All e-readers must have cellular and network capabilities disabled (turned off) while the device is at school. No devices will be allowed at recess. iPhones will not be allowed as e-readers during the school day.

The devices being used and the books being read on the e-reader at school must be approved by the IHM-St. Casimir teacher, and the teacher has full discretion as to what is being read and when the e-reader may be used within the school day.

If a student violates any portion of this policy, his/her e-reader will be placed in the office for the student's parent to pick up at their earliest convenience, and the student will immediately lose the privilege to use the e-reader at school for a length of time commensurate with the nature of the violation.

A student who brings his/her e-reader to school is personally responsible for the device. The school assumes no responsibility for the loss of, theft of, or damage to any personal device. Additionally, the student is responsible for knowing how to use his/her e-reader, and this should not be a burden for the teacher.

_____ I give permission to my child to use an e-reader during the school day at no responsibility of the school.

_____ My child will let the teacher see what book is being read on the e-reader while at school.

_____ My child will only utilize the e-reader at school at the discretion of the teacher.

To be allowed an e-reader device in school, all the above statements must be initialed by the parent/guardian.
